## **RULES**

- 1. The ITF Junior Circuit Code of Conduct will be in force at the events and the tournaments played in accordance with the Rules of the ITF.
- 2. All draws will be conducted in accordance with the ITF Junior Circuit Rules and Regulations.
- 3. A default will be given if a player fails to appear 15 minutes after his/her match is called.
- 4. Customary dress code will be enforced.
- 5. In entering the tournament, a player automatically grants to the VTF and/or the sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show pictures of him/her in motion or still, taken during the competition without compensation.
- 6. Prior to the draw being made an identity card or passport showing the date of birth for each player may be asked to be presented to the referee.
