Countries requiring a visa: Jordan, Kuwait, Pacific Oceania, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Syria

Countries not requiring a visa: Cambodia, Malaysia (less than 30 days) (Passports must be valid at least 6 monthsfromthe date of entry).

It is responsibility of every participating nation to check with their embassy if they require a VISA to travel to the hosting country as well as to ensure that all the members of the teams have all the required vaccinations to access that country. Please also check with your travel agent.

The ITF does not have any power or influence over diplomatic procedures set by governments; therefore, we have no power to shorten the timelines to obtain a visa or fast track a process with an embassy.

To apply for a visa via the following information is obligatory:

VISA ON ARRIVAL:

After the letter of approval is obtained, all participants are required to bring along the following documents for visa pickup at Noi Bai Airport:

- 1. A color scanned copy of approval letter
- 2. Filled in arrival form issued by the Immigration Bureau
- 3. 2 passport sized photographs (4cm x 6cm)
- 4. Payment of Visa On Arrival processing fees
- 5. Visa fees: For Approval Letter: 1-3 USD (Price depends on his/ her type of visa)
- 6. Stamping Fee:

For Single Entry: 25 USD For Multiple Entry: 50 USD

For 6 months Multiple Entry: 95 USD For 1 year Multiple Entry: 135 USD
